

To whom it may concern,

Public Service Electric and Gas is seeking permission to temporally occupy lot #28 Block #207; A P.S.E & G Utility right of way owned by the Borough of Glen Rock off Harristown Rd. across from Rodney St as a remote report site. As part of our ongoing commitment to replacing aging infrastructure, P.S.E & G will be replacing gas mains and services in the towns of Glen Rock, Waldwick, Ridgewood and Ramsey. The primary reason for any remote site is to gain job site time on our projects thereby reducing costs. There will be no work performed on the remote site; it will be used to park the following

- 1 mobile work trailer
- 1 port-o-john
- 1 utility street truck,
- 1 dump truck
- 1 back hoe and
- 1 back hoe trailer.

In addition, there will be 3 employee personal vehicles on site during the day. Our estimated time frame to occupy the site will be from on or about 4-9-12 until on or about 10-15-12. Our scheduled work hours are from 7:00 am till 3:30 pm Monday thru Saturday. Employees will arrive on the site at approximately 6:45 am leaving the remote site with work vehicles at approximately 7:15 am and returning to site at approximately 3:15 pm (typical work day). On occasion, there will be overtime involved with our replacement projects that will result in the arrival time back at the site being later.

At no time will there be any type of vehicles or equipment left running, idling or unattended for the duration of the time P.S.E & G. is occupying the site.
