In addition to the Glen “ROCKS” program, created and managed by the school counselor, classroom teachers are constantly engaged in character education in the classroom. Each classroom teacher either presents a weekly character education lesson or holds a brief daily meeting that they feel addresses any issues in their classroom or that highlights an important lesson that they would like to focus on in their class community. Additionally, Mr. Holmgren sees grades 2-5 approximately twice a month to reinforce the traits in our Glen “ROCKS” program and address current issues and challenges as they occur in school. Our school counselor, Mrs. Falkenstern also works in the classrooms and individually with students to address common issues and needs proactively and as they may surface.
