FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA) NOTICE

The Federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act has imposed new accountability and reporting requirements on the State and local school districts. A provision of this federal law requires notification to parents regarding their rights as parents, and the responsibility of the school district to maintain clear and accurate records of student achievement. Part of this NCLB requires a notification to you of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

FERPA requires that you be notified that you have access to your child's records and progress, as well as any particular record of note regarding achievement, and/or discipline. Additionally, FERPA allows you to access the specific reporting of the school district to the State of New Jersey. Such reporting includes State Report Cards, test analyses, college and post-secondary statistics, as well as any particular survey created by third parties to be administered in the school district to students. The collection of personal information is an area that is safeguarded by the school district. We are not telemarketers or commercial vendors, so you can be assured that this information stays within the school district. As a parent you have a right to inspect, upon request, any instrument used for the collection of this information. As a parent of a high school student, please be aware that student information may be used by military recruiters.

Please be assured that this district allows for the open access of information upon a reasonable request. Know, however, that this data is available in the schools, and you may peruse general information if you wish.
